<p>The holiday season is a wonderful time to be able to teach your preschool child generosity and empathy, simply by setting examples and encouraging participation. A three- to four- year old who is ready developmentally (i.e. is taking on a little responsibility; learning cooperation, and showing a strong desire for approval), can reap lifelong benefits from these early lessons in helpfulness.</p> <p><u>Giving to Toy Banks</u></p> <p>Remembering that the concept of ownership is difficult for younger preschoolers. Donating to toy banks is best done by using a "twin toy"; buy two of the same item, one for your child and one as the donation item. Because it's a painless donation, the positive feedback (an actual thank you from the charitable organization staff member and/or your own praise for your preschooler's action plus a comment as to how happy the recipient child will be) is unclouded and the joy of giving is just that.</p> <p>When your child is ready to either give up a gently used toy or choose a new one specifically for the toy drive, then the act will become even more meaningful.</p> 	<h2 style="text-align: center;">Parent Reminders</h2> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
